





The Order of Blessing a Married Couple

Archbishop: My dear brothers and sisters

Turn to the Lord in prayer,

Wives: (repeat after the Archbishop)

Blessed are you, Lord

for by your goodness I took (Name) as my husband.

Both: Blessed are you, Lord,

for in the good and the bad times of our life

you have stood lovingly by our side.

Help us, we pray,

to remain faithful in our love for one another,

so that we may be true witnesses

to the covenant you have made with humankind.

(spouses face one another and join hands for the Blessing)

Archbishop: Let us Pray,

Increase and sanctify, Lord the love of your servants,

that they may always grow in the grace of the Sacrament of Marriage. Keep them safe all the days of their lives. Be their comfort in adversity,

and support in prosperity. And fill their homes and families with your blessings.

Through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.




